Members to be drawn from the following:

- Two elected members of council
- The Chief Executive Officer, or their nominee
- Coordinator Community Programs
- Senior Community Development Officer Access, Inclusion and Social Programs
- One representative who works with people with disability
- Up to five community representatives with an interest in and passion for the purpose of the committee

Purpose:

The objective of the Committee is to be a key source of advice to the Council and officers by:

- Identifying issues related to disability access and inclusion in the City of Subiaco
- Sharing information on strategies and plans to enhance disability access and inclusion
- Promoting the wellbeing and sense of belonging of people with disabilities by the city itself, or in association with government agencies, community groups, private organisations, businesses and individuals
- Facilitating stakeholder and community input to the city and other key organisations with respect to disability access and inclusion
- Raising awareness and informing the community about matters relating to disability access and inclusion in the city.

Meetings:

The committee meets twice yearly, or more regularly as required.

Delegated Authority:

There are no powers delegated to this Committee

Reporting:

Recommendations from this Committee will be referred to Council for consideration.

Term:

Appointment is for two years or until the next ordinary local government election day (whichever happens first) and members are eligible for re-appointment.
