City of Subiaco bulk waste collection

The City of Subiaco offers a bulk waste collection twice yearly. To find out when the next collection is, visit www.subiaco.wa.gov.au/bulkwaste.

The following items can be placed out for bulk waste collection

- Furniture
- Timber products (up to 1.5m in length)
- Stoves and refrigerators with doors removed
- e-Waste and electronic items
- Steel and metal item (up to 1.5m in length)
- Gas cylinders

Note: Gas cylinders must be placed away from other items for occupational, health and safety purposes, as they will be collected separately.

The following items cannot be placed out for bulk waste collection

- Glass of any kind
- Garden waste
- Bricks, builder's rubble, sand or cement
- Foodstuffs and household waste including medicines
- Motor vehicles, car parts, tyres and batteries
- Flammable liquids and other hazardous materials
- Paint and oil
- Asbestos, cement products

Note: Many of the items not accepted for bulk rubbish can be taken to the **JFR (Jim) McGeough Resource Recovery Facility**.
