

New development to provide quality aged care

The City of Subiaco is working with Berrington Care Group to provide a new 112-bed residential aged care facility in Bishop Street, Jolimont.

The three-storey boutique development is due to open in mid-March.

Mayor Heather Henderson said the high care facility would provide an important service to the local community that does not currently exist and for which there is high demand.

"It is wonderful to see a high care facility developed in the area to provide much-needed 24-hour care," Mayor Henderson said.

"As well as providing a high quality modern facility, the development will also generate revenue for the city through lease income.

"The city has leased the 5000 square metres of land at 45–47 Bishop Street, Jolimont for a 25 year term with a 25 year option.

"This is one of a number of projects the city is undertaking to revitalise and improve the visual amenity in the area."

Berrington Care Group Director Ken Loughton said the group was excited to work in partnership with the city to provide the new facility.

"The Berrington Subiaco development has been designed to focus on residents to provide the highest quality aged care in the heart of Subiaco.

"The facility is staffed by a large team of professionals, on hand 24 hours a day to provide all aspects of care and hospitality."
