Perth Harmony Chorus, Perth's leading female barbershop ensemble, will delight at the City of Subiaco's sunday@subi concert on Sunday 28 July.

The group of up to one hundred women come together to share a love of four-part barbershop harmony and performance.

Perth Harmony Chorus Director Carole Macintyre said the group performed a barbershop style of a cappella music.

"The defining characteristic of barbershop style is the ringing chord; an extra tone that can be heard ringing above the actual sung notes and, when detected, can cause goose bumps.

"Many of our songs also involve choreography, animated faces and bright costumes to make the show a visual, as well as an audio spectacular," Carole said.

Tickets are available from 1.15pm on the day of the concert and are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. All attendees must be present when the tickets are allocated. There will be a short break during the concert where attendees can enjoy a coffee or drink from the bar.

The sunday@subi free concert series covers a mix of themes and genres suitable for all ages. The concerts run every Sunday until 25 August at 2pm at the Subiaco Art Centre, 180 Hamersley Road, Subiaco.
