Subi's future for kids

The City of Subiaco's child-friendly strategic plan *Subi's Future – For Kids* is a first for local government globally.

The booklet adapts the city's Strategic Community Plan and Corporate Business Plan, and uses interactive learning to help children recognise the role they play in the future of our city.

Mayor Henderson said it was great to see young children taking such an interest in Subiaco's future.

"Subi's Future – For Kids takes the key elements from both of the plans and puts it into language that appeals to children."

"The city is leading the way in engagement with children in our community, and I am always impressed with the enthusiasm and passion they have for Subiaco," Mayor Henderson said.

Activities in the booklet are designed to be a valuable resource for teachers and parents to educate children about their community.

The booklet was developed by Project Artspace, in collaboration with children from the Subiaco Kids Crew, Subiaco and Rosalie primary schools.

Local children also recently participated in a creative short film adaptation of the booklet during a film workshop through Filmbites Youth Film School.
