Registrations are now open for Race around Subi 2013, and for the first time, competitors are encouraged to dress up for the event, with prizes going to the best dressed team.

The event will take place on Saturday 9 November from 9am to 12pm, commencing and finishing at the Subi Farmers Market, Subiaco Primary School. Registration is free and includes a complimentary sausage sizzle and the chance to win fantastic prizes.

Mayor Henderson said "Race around Subi is always lots of fun. It attracts a diverse range of participants of all ages and is a great way to enjoy a day out in Subiaco."

The popular annual event organised by City of Subiaco and Subi Voice of Youth is loosely based on the hit television show *The Amazing Race*. Teams compete in a thrilling adventure around Subiaco, with the ultimate goal to be the fastest to complete a series of fun challenges before crossing the finish line.

Last year's Race around Subi event saw thirty-five teams and over 120 participants compete. This year's event is expected to attract an even larger crowd.
