Shutter closing on the 2013 Photographic Awards

Aspiring photographers have until 5pm on Monday 9 September to enter the City of Subiaco's 2013 Photographic Awards. Winners will share a total prize pool of \$2500.

Entrants may submit up to two photographs in the open or Subiaco categories. Entries in the Subiaco category must be taken within the city and fit the theme of 'meeting place'.

Mayor Heather Henderson said: "The awards are an opportunity to celebrate creativity in Subiaco. Whether you've taken a great photo this year or feel inspired to go out and capture a special moment this weekend, the city wants to see it."

2013 marks the twelfth year of the awards, which are open to all residents in the Perth metropolitan area aged six years and over.

Mayor Henderson noted: "The judges will be looking for relevance, composition, creativity, technical quality and overall impression."

An exhibition of finalists' work can be viewed from Saturday 9 November until Sunday 24 November at Subiaco Library.
