### Discover the secrets of Subi on Sundays

Subiaco's popular *See Subi on Sunday* tour series will launch with an exploration of Subiaco's rich wartime history with a fascinating look at the story behind the Subiaco Fallen Soldiers Memorial and the city's crest, including a visit to Subiaco Museum.

Now in its fourteenth year, the series will kick off on Sunday 12 July 2015, and conclude on Mother's Day 2016.

City of Subiaco Mayor Heather Henderson said the free tours offer the community a unique way to explore the city and discover the captivating history of Subiaco.

"Following immense success during the 2014–2015 season, this year's series looks at the city's hidden treasures, the history of which illustrate the transformation and growth of Subiaco to the vibrant city it is today."

This year the series also includes a fascinating look at the history of maternity services at King Edward Memorial Hospital, the interesting personality of former WA Premier Henry Daglish, and an afternoon of petanque at Palms Community Centre.

City volunteer and tour coordinator Marion Gathercole researches all of the tours herself and says the diversity of this year's program ensures there is something for everyone on Sundays in Subiaco.

"Each tour is unique and offers a different perspective on the history of Subiaco. Having coordinated the tours for the past fourteen years, the historical aspects of our community that they uncover continue to amaze me." said Marion.

Mayor Henderson added: "It is wonderful to see *See Subi on Sunday* celebrate its fourteenth anniversary. Its continued success is testament to the hard work of Marion, and reflects a strong passion and respect for preserving and sharing the history of our city."
