MAKE THE MOST OF SUBIACO CHILDREN'S LIBRARY

Did you know that Subiaco Library has a dedicated children's library? This lively space offers children the opportunity to learn, have fun and take part in regular activities, such as Storytime and Baby Rhymetime.

Storytime is a story-telling session for pre-schoolers and is followed by a fun craft activity. During the school term, storytelling sessions are held on Tuesdays at 10.30am and are repeated on Fridays at 10.30am. During school holidays, Storytime is held on Fridays only.

Baby Rhymetime is for parents and babies aged two months to two years. These sessions introduce fun ways of sharing nursery rhymes and action songs with your baby. Baby Rhymetime is held on Mondays and Wednesdays at 10am. During school holidays, it is held on Mondays only.

WHAT'S NEXT FOR LOCAL PLANNING SCHEME NO. 5?

Public consultation on the city's draft Local Planning Scheme No. 5 and draft Local Planning Strategy closed on Friday 13 July and the City of Subiaco would like to thank those who took part.

During the consultation period, more than 500 community members attended open days to understand the proposed changes to the planning rules in their neighbourhoods. The city received hundreds of valuable responses and enquiries.

The city now has four months to collate and evaluate all the responses in order to identify issues and trends raised by the community. Council will consider all feedback and make a recommendation which will be sent to the Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) for consideration.

Once submitted, the WAPC has four months to consider the local planning scheme and submit its recommendation to the Minister for Planning, who is the final decision-maker on the scheme.
