VERGE LANDSCAPING

The City of Subiaco encourages residents to establish and maintain the verge adjacent to their property with landscaping that incorporates low water use plants. The city's website contains tips on how you can green your verge, guidelines for verge development and information on our development assistance scheme. GREEN WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE: MINIMUM OF FOUR BAGS

In the City of Subiaco, green waste is collected weekly, on the same day as your general waste. Some restrictions apply – make sure you place a minimum of four green waste bags (\$4.50 each from the Administration Centre) and a maximum of ten on the verge for collection.

For tree trunks, branches, prunings and green waste pile size restrictions also apply. Visit www.subiaco.wa.gov.au/waste for details.
