Historical Notes	Nicholl Street was first identified in Western Australian Post Office Directory in 1942, by which time 2 houses had been built. Development ceased along the street during the war-years, but 10 additional houses were erected between 1945 and 1949, reflecting the impetus of the post-war boom. By the end of the 1940s, only the two lots at the north-western end of the street (#s 12 & 21) remained vacant.
