Historical Notes	In July 1906 a two roomed brick building was under construction, opening on 15 October with 67 students. It grew rapidly. Originally it was known as 'Rosalea' or 'West Subiaco' school.
Physical Description	School group comprising buildings from various periods from the early 1900s to the 1990s. Buildings generally brick and iron. The earlier buildings on the site exhibit characteristics typical of early schools including tall brick chimney with corbelling and double hung sash windows with small panes.
Associations	Unknown
Statement of Significance	The place has historic significance representing the development and settlement of the area, and also the provision of education in the State. It has social significance to the local community, in particular the past and present students and staff.
