Physical Description	Single storey painted tuck-pointed brick and corrugated iron double fronted residence. The walls have a rendered strip at sill height and the roof is hipped with a vent gable. There are two brick chimneys with decorative corbelling. The red painted bull nosed verandah extends across the width of the facade and has turned timber posts. The front door has plain glass fanlights and sidelights and there are timber casement sash windows.

Statement of Significance	The place has aesthetic significance as a good example of the architectural style typical of the area and period. It has historic significance reflecting the development and settlement of the area.
