| Historical Notes | Existing structure built in 1990s. The land for the railway was surveyed in 1878, and the line from Fremantle to Guildford was completed in 1881. Shenton Park station (original West Subiaco) was built in 1908 |
| Physical Description | The shelter is a light steel framed structure with curved butterfly roof. Three central columns supporting curved steel roof structure. Glazed panels with infill panels below at either end of building. Exposed footings. The platform surface is paved brick. |

| Statement of Significance | The place has social significance as a station on the Fremantle to Perth railway providing a service for the people of Subiaco |
