Endemic Plant Species to the City of Subiaco

Introduction

The City has adopted [Local Planning Policy 1.3 – Sustainable Development](#) (LPP 1.3) which requires new single houses, grouped dwellings and significant additions/alterations to include sustainability in the design. The vegetation related sustainability measures under Table 1 of LPP 1.3 are:

- **Item 9:** Providing a water wise landscaping area (water wise plants as defined by the [Water Corporation](#))
- **Item 10:** Retaining a mature tree on-site
- **Item 11:** Providing a new tree on-site (in addition to what is required under [Residential Design Codes – Volume 1](#)).

Endemic plants include species which can only be found in a certain region. Endemic plants can improve biodiversity and create healthy ecosystems. You may wish to consider choosing endemic plant species for the City of Subiaco area (**Table 1** and **2**), when choosing sustainability measure items 9, 10 and/or 11 under LPP 1.3.

This information sheet provides a list of endemic plants to the City of Subiaco area (**Table 1** and **2**), as a guide for proponents choosing to incorporate endemic plant species into their gardens.
