## Regulation 61 - Local Government Approval of Batter Powered Smoke Alarms

Pursuant to the *Building Regulations 2012* a local government may approve the use of a battery powered smoke alarm, rather than one that is connected to the mains power supply, in a dwelling or part of a dwelling.

The local government may also give its approval in relation to an alarm that was installed before the approval is to be given.

1. Completed Application Form. Please ensure that the details and signature are the owner of the building.
2. Building layout plans showing size of rooms and location of proposed smoke alarm.
3. A letter from a licensed electrician to confirm that installing a mains powered smoke alarm would involve a sufficient problem as described in the Regulation above.
4. Details and specifications of smoke detectors in accordance with the Building Code.
5. Application Fee - **\$179.40** (The City will contact applicants to arrange payment of the fee upon receipt of an application).
