SEAT provides a walk-in service at The Third Place, as well as an assertive outreach response in the City of Subiaco.

The Team of Assertive Outreach Support Workers can provide:

- Engagement and support
- Assessment
- Information
- Advocacy and referrals
- Explore accommodation options
- Essential items such as; blankets, sleeping bags, clothing, hygiene packs and water.
- Walk-in service – hot meals, hot drinks and access to showers

The Team aim to support you to address concerns and issues you may be facing, relating to your current housing or homelessness situation.

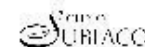
The SEAT will provide non-judgmental, person-centered and trauma-informed services to ensure that individuals in need are provided with safe and appropriate support.
