# **Local government reforms**

Significant reform to the local government sector has recently been announced but for the City of Subiaco, no changes will be needed.

Last year, the size of the Council was reduced and Elected Members resolved to continue with the method of popularly electing the Mayor - both of which are outlined in the new reforms.

City of Subiaco Mayor David McMullen said: "As to the reforms more generally, Council has previously emphasized the importance of cultural change, better understanding of governance at a practical level, and better real world understanding of statutory roles, over a reliance on legislative reform as the pathway to success in local government.

"Council has also been clear in its rejection of preferential voting, because of what we consider to be its susceptibility to influence and interference from political parties."
