Composite decking at Lake Jualbup in Shenton Park has been given a makeover, complete with new boards and laser-cut screens which feature images of a variety of fauna found in and around the lake.

Reflecting upon the area's historical Noongar connections, the deck screens depict 'maarle', the black swan, 'gorya', the frog, and 'boorda yarrkiny', the turtle.

An original piece of artwork which featured these three animals was erected by Shane Pickett at Lake Jualbup in 1996. A description of each animal was written on the side of the artwork, and has been adapted for the new viewing deck's signage.
