New policy seeks sustainable development

An innovative new policy aimed at making select residential developments more sustainable is a step closer after Council voted to advertise the draft for public comment.

The policy aims to facilitate better environmental outcomes by requiring applicable residential developments to include specific sustainability measures in the design.

It would apply to new single homes, grouped dwellings, and significant additions and/or alterations.

Library restoration update

The restoration of Evelyn H Parker (Subiaco) Library to its former glory is a step closer after Council awarded the tender for works.

The library is a landmark building in Subiaco but past landscape and design choices coupled with rising damp has resulted in a decline in the condition of the exterior of the building.

The project will restore, remediate and ultimately enhance the exterior of this important building that forms part of the City’s Local Heritage Register, preserving it for future generations.

The tender award means the project can now progress to implementation, which will include a period of closure (estimated to be 3-4 months); during this time a pop-up library will be established in the former Council Chambers at 241 Rokeby Road.

Works at Subiaco station

The Public Transport Authority (PTA) will be replacing the lifts and escalators at Subiaco Train Station.

Works will begin in August and are expected to be completed by mid-2024.

Passengers with accessibility requirements are encouraged to use Daglish or West Leederville stations during the work as the lifts will be out of service.
