## **Council recommends** Sanur DA be refused

The City will recommend that the Metro Inner-North Joint Development Assessment Panel (JDAP) refuse a development application at 424-428 and 440 Hay Street in its Responsible Authority Report.

It comes after a staff recommendation for refusal was unanimously endorsed by Elected Members at this week's Ordinary Council Meeting.

The City received a Development Assessment Panel application for the properties in September proposing the demolition of the existing buildings which have heritage value – and construction of replica buildings.

The development application is inconsistent with the City's Local Planning Scheme No. 5.

The matter will now go to JDAP for a decision.
