



Residents reduce waste to landfill by 20 per cent

City of Subiaco residents have reduced waste to landfill by 20 per cent in just six months after the implementation of FOGO (Food Organics and Garden Organics).

Since its implementation in May 2023, City residents have diverted more than 800 tonnes of methane-producing organics from landfill, contributing to a more circular economy.

Contamination rates of FOGO are around two per cent – which is considered low to medium – with soft plastics accounting for the majority of this.

Mayor David McMullen said this was a good outcome for the environment.

“The community has really embraced FOGO and the numbers reflect this – with an impressive 20 per cent reduction in waste to landfill,” he said.

“We expected that FOGO would have a significant and long-lasting impact on the environment so it’s encouraging to now start seeing data to quantify how much the change is paying off.”

Town Centre Parking Precinct Plan adopted

Following public consultation and adoption by Council at its meeting on 21 November, the City of Subiaco will implement changes to parking in the town centre precinct in the next three months.

Up to 23,920 additional parking opportunities per year will be generated for motorists in the area of high demand surrounding King Edward Memorial Hospital through the introduction of a three-hour limit Monday to Friday, with a first hour free option and fees thereafter.
