



Disability Access and Inclusion Committee Terms of Reference

Establishment

The Disability Access and Inclusion Committee is established by the City of Subiaco under Section 5.8 of the *Local Government Act 1995*.

Objective

The objective of the Committee is to provide advice to Council to ensure disability access and inclusion to facilities, services and information.

Areas of responsibility

To provide advice and recommendations to the Council in relation to:

1. Identifying issues related to disability access and inclusion in the City of Subiaco.
2. Sharing information on strategies and plans to enhance disability access and inclusion.
3. Promoting the wellbeing and sense of belonging of people with disabilities by the City itself, or in association with government agencies, community groups, private organisations, businesses and individuals.
4. Facilitating stakeholder and community input to the City and other key organisations with respect to disability access and inclusion.
5. Raising awareness and informing the community about matters relating to disability access and inclusion in the City.

Membership

The Committee consists of:

- The Mayor (if they nominate) and two (2) Elected Members unless otherwise determined by Council.
- Up to six (6) community representatives with a lived experience of disability and/or representatives that work with people with disability

Meetings

The Committee meets tri-annually or as required.

Delegated Authority

There are no powers delegated to this Committee.

Reporting

Recommendations from this Committee will be referred to Council for consideration.

Term

Appointment is for two years or until the next ordinary local government election day (whichever happens first).
