The Subiaco Museum has a wonderful collection of historical needlework. Many of these items display handcraft skills such as sewing, quilting, knitting and crocheting which were often taught at school. Come along to the museum and practice some basic stitches and create your own picture on hessian.

The picture you create can be a collection of sewing colourful threads and buttons onto the hessian or be as simple as gluing pieces of felt and material onto the hessian. You be the artist and create the picture of your choice.
