Mayor Penny Taylor	Cr David McMullen	The Local Government Standards Panel found that Mayor Penny Taylor, a councillor for the City of Subiaco, committed three minor breaches under the <i>Local Government Act 1995</i> ad regulation 7 of the <i>Local Government (Rules of Conduct) Regulations 2007</i> when she made certain comments that were published in an article on the West Australian website by Michael Traill dated 21 November 2020 entitled " <i>Subiaco Mayor 'facing coup' as ex-councillor Malcolm Mummery fights to take the mayoral vote from electors</i> ".
