



Disability Access and Inclusion Committee TERMS OF REFERENCE

Members to be drawn from the following:

- The Mayor (if they nominate) and Two (2) Councillors
- Minimum of two representatives that work with people with disability
- Up to four community representatives with an interest in and passion for the purpose of the committee, including a minimum of one person living with disability

Staff Representatives:

- The Chief Executive Officer, or their nominee
- Coordinator Community Development
- Community Development Officer - Social Inclusion

Purpose:

The objective of the Committee is to be a key source of advice to the Council and officers by:

- Identifying issues related to disability access and inclusion in the City of Subiaco.
- Sharing information on strategies and plans to enhance disability access and inclusion.
- Promoting the wellbeing and sense of belonging of people with disabilities by the city itself, or in association with government agencies, community groups, private organisations, businesses and individuals.
- Facilitating stakeholder and community input to the city and other key organisations with respect to disability access and inclusion.
- Raising awareness and informing the community about matters relating to disability access and inclusion in the city.

Meetings:

The committee meets three times per annum, with the Chair able to request a Special Meeting/s if required.

Delegated Authority:

There are no powers delegated to this Committee.

Reporting:

Recommendations from this Committee will be referred to Council for consideration.

Term:

Appointment is for two years or until the next ordinary local government election day (whichever happens first) and members are eligible for re-appointment.
