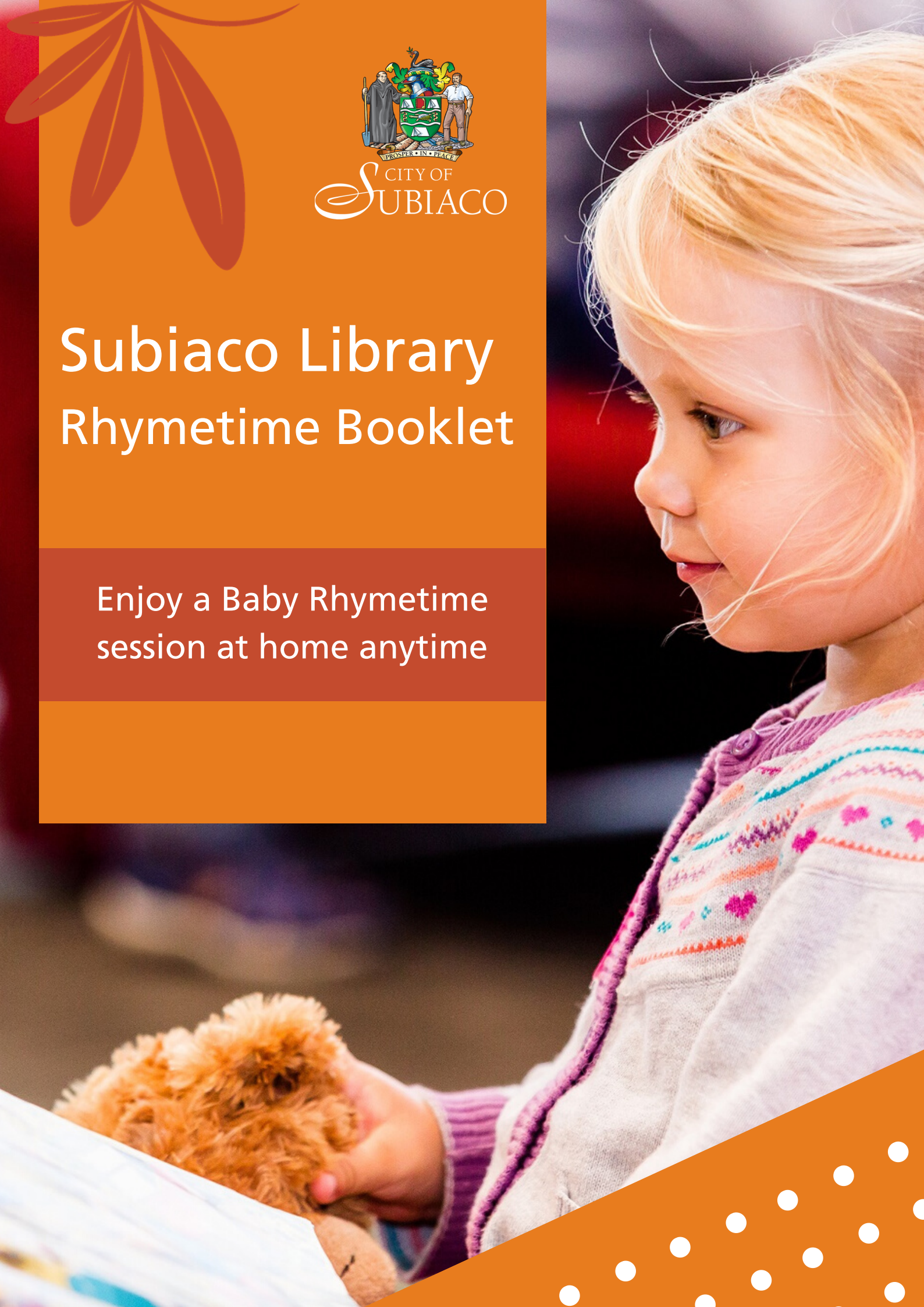

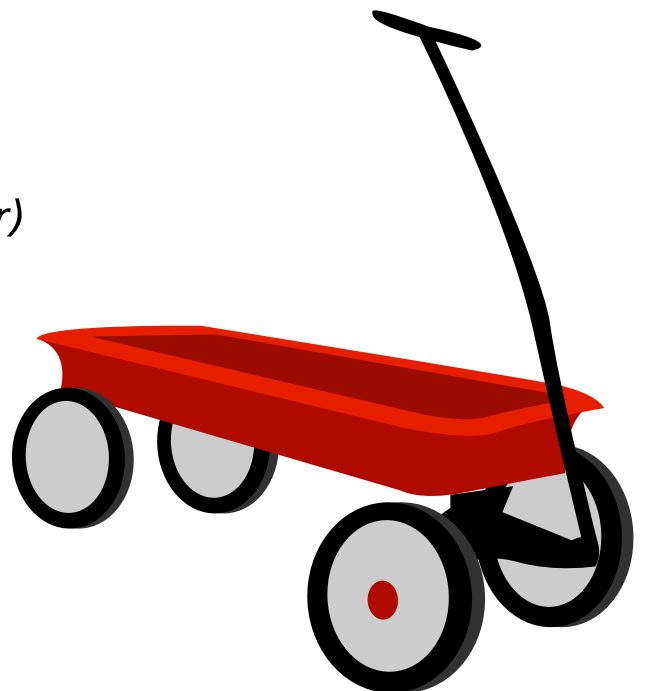
Little Red Wagon

Pat-a-cake, pat-a-cake

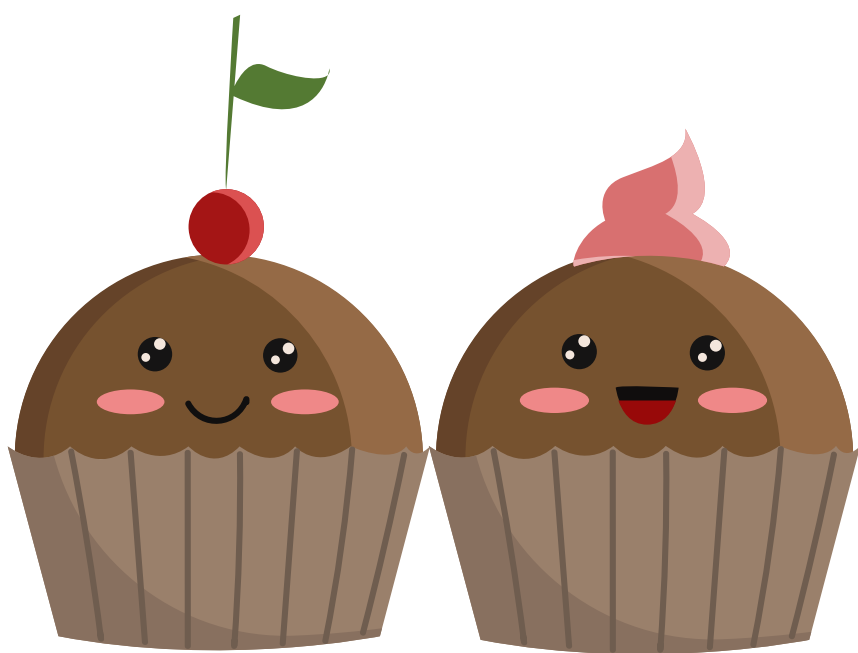
Pat-a-cake, pat-a-cake, baker's man,

But... we all know frogs go la-Dee-da-Dee-da,

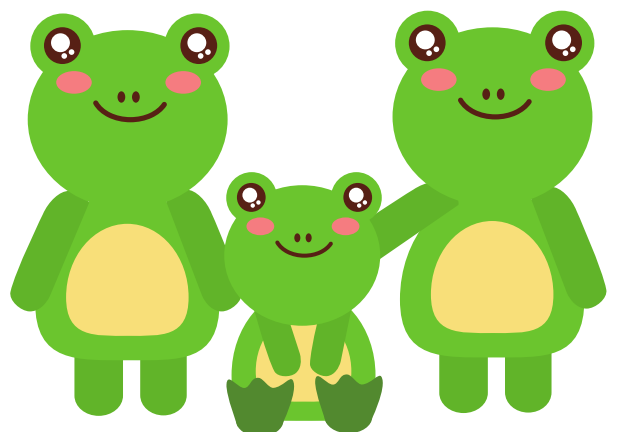
(Rock baby from side to side on la-Dee-da-Dee-da)

The door on the bus goes open and shut...

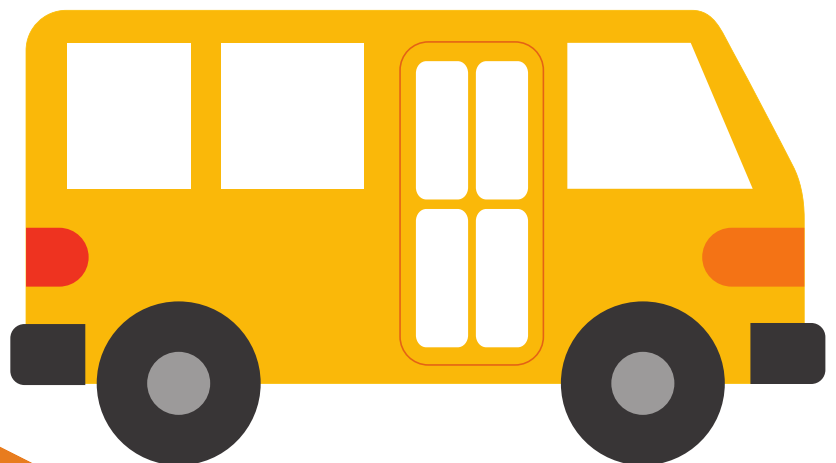
The horn on the bus goes beep, beep, beep...

And this little piggy had none.

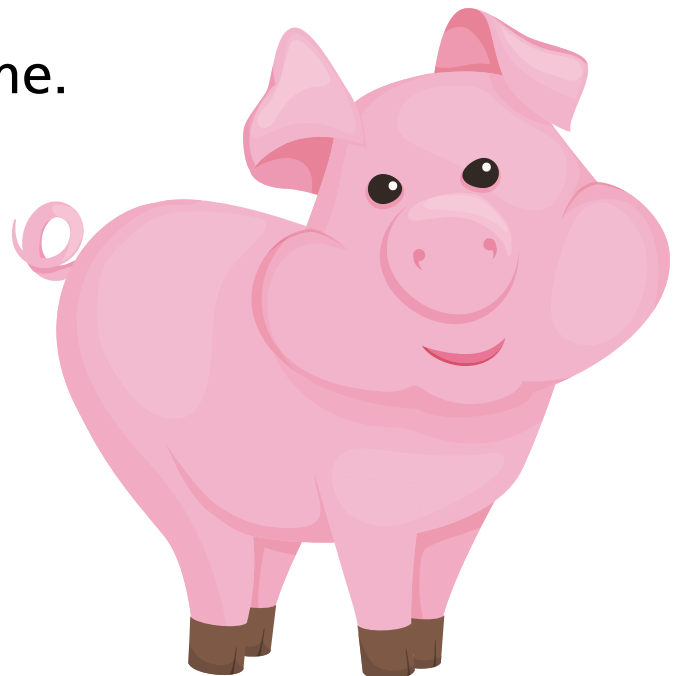
(Touch forth toe)

Splashing all around in the deep blue sea.

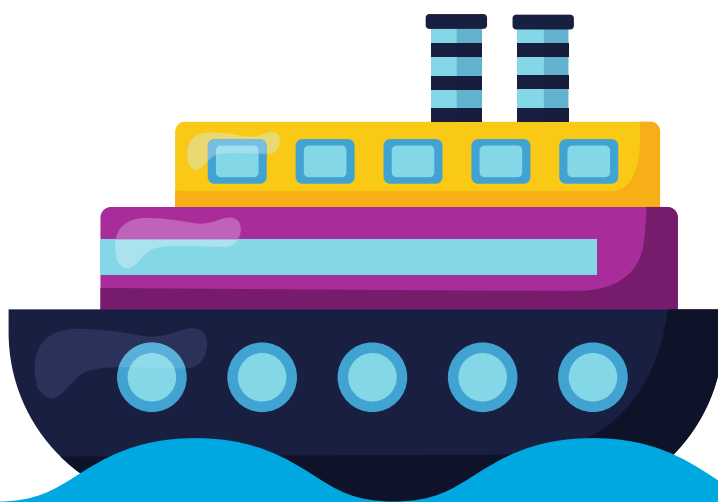
Splash, splash, splash, splash won't you splash with me?

(Put one fist on top of the other)

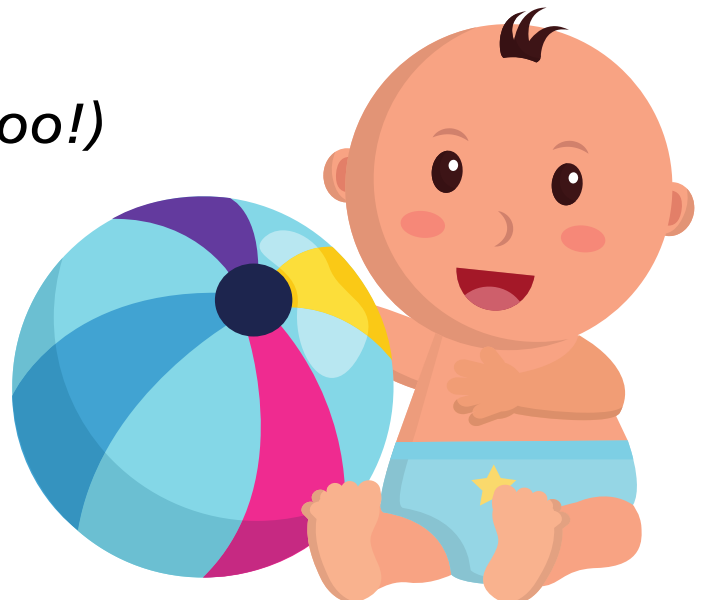
Look how you can pound!

Hickory Dickory Dock

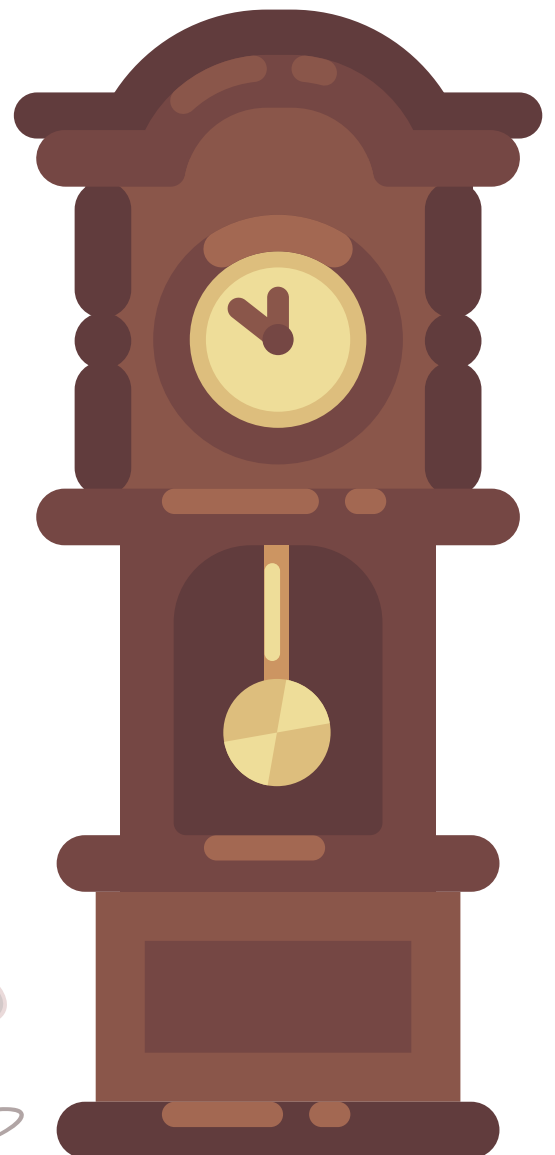
Hickory Dickory Dock,
