Year One Program

Focus: Present and Past Family Life

Year One students will role play daily lives of Subiaco families from the early 1900s by handling collection items and dressing up in 1900s costumes.

They can dig deep into the museum trunk and explore historical photographs and objects that belonged to families from the past. They will discover for themselves how families have changed or stayed the same.

Through playing the 'Then' and 'Now' game students can consider the differences and similarities of past and present-day family life.

Focus: The Past in the present and Changes in technology

Year Two students will learn about life in the past through hands-on olden day activities and games.
